Prejudice: hatred or unfair treatment toward a person or group without cause or reason. Prejudice is often directed toward people of a certain race or religion.

Discrimination: the act of treating some people unfairly because of prejudice.

Equity: the quality of being fair and reasonable; fairness.

Intolerance: not able or not willing to accept different opinions, beliefs, customs, or people; not tolerant.

Systemic Racism: persistent discrimination, both subtle and direct, on the part of members of the racial group that holds the greatest wealth and power within a society against members of other racial groups, resulting in inequities in such areas as income, job opportunities, access to voting and healthcare, and treatment by law enforcement officials.

Police Brutality: the condition or quality of law enforcement officials being brutal or very cruel.

Injustice: the lack of justice or fairness.

Trauma: an emotional shock that has a deep effect on one's life for a long time.
